"Sometimes it can be genetic, sometimes it's due to trauma, but whatever the reason for hair loss, we try to restore the situation and provide patients with thick, lustrous hair," says Dr. Verret. "Whether it's the hairline, male/female-pattern baldness or even the eyebrows, we have the technologies and treatments to fix the problem." Sometimes the suggestion might be nonsurgical and require the daily use of topical products or state-of-the-art laser technology; other times it may require hair transplantation. "Whatever the concern, we have a solution."

The sagging skin around her mouth, chin and neck made this 60-year-old patient feel like her face looked drawn and older. She sought Dr. Verret to address her concerns. "We opted for a SMAS facelift, including platysmaplasty to correct the loose skin in that area," Dr. Verret says. "Now the slack skin is gone and her jaw line is defined and smooth."
